

Use matching Prefix for projections (i.e 02 Boys dance rain image.jpg)




# Get the right quality

# Lighting



### **Make a List of Cues**

**Don't worry about technical terms** - we work with creatives all day! Describe as best as you can what you imagine for each moment.

If possible include black outs, blue-outs, snap to black, fade out

## More Info = Faster Programming

**Programming lights will take approx. twice the length of the show running time -** A 2hr show will take around 4hrs to program. The more prepared you are for this, the speedier we can be!

Arrange a meeting or ask for help - We have a generic lighting setup that works for most dance shows, plays and musicals. If you have specific requests, ideas or requirements; get in touch and we can discuss the options!



#### **Handhelds or Radio Mic Headsets?**


Plan out the best use of the microphones to avoid quick swaps of headsets and whats best for your cast and production.

Make a detailed Mic Plot that shows which Cast memeber is on which mic for each scene or song.



Your sound technician doesn't know your show like you do.

Mark up the script to show which Mics are needed for each song and scene.



**Make tough decisions** - who *needs* mics and which are luxurys.

Broken headsets cost £55.00 - Planning in advance and avoiding quick changes will massively reduce the chances of damage.

Allocate one member of your team to be in charge of mics and changes.
